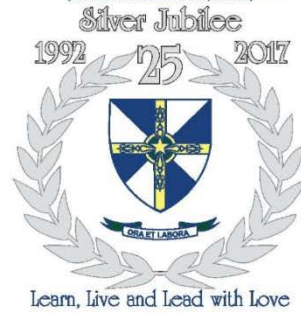

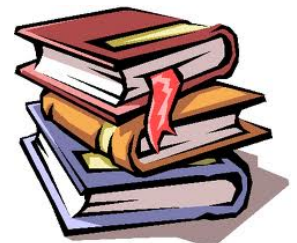
A very big, **thank you**, to our Veritas Families for supporting this initiative.

### ACADEMIC NEWS

At the end of the second term and during the first two weeks of the third term teachers will be completing interviews with parents of children who are not performing well academically. Veritas College

has a very clear policy regarding promoting and retaining pupils. By the end of September parents will have been informed if there is a possibility of their child having to repeat their present Grade. This decision is not taken lightly and is not



finalised until the end of November. It is not in a child's best interest to progress to the next grade if they have not mastered the necessary skills in their present grade. Various factors are taken into consideration when making this decision i.e. age appropriateness, recommendations by Teachers, Educational Psychologists and/or Occupational Therapists.

Term 3 is a very short term and parents are urged to keep abreast of their children's academic progress and make an appointment to see the teacher if they are at all concerned.

- **Final Examinations**, for the Grade 4 – 7 pupils begin on **Wednesday, 8 November**. 'What to Study Lists' will be distributed early in October.
- Please note that as from **Tuesday, 7 November** (the start of the final examinations), until the end of the year, school will close at 12:00 for **ALL** pupils. There will be waiting classes available until 13:00 for children who are unable to be fetched by 12:00. After-School Care will commence at 13:00.

A few important points regarding the Revue:

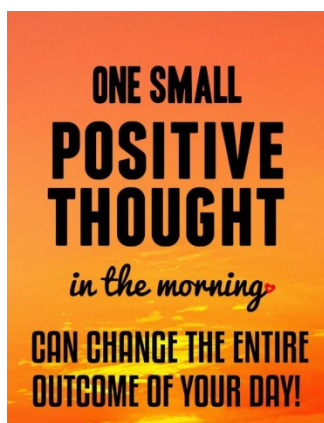
- The dates for the shows are as follows: **Tuesday, 19 September ; Wednesday, 20 and Thursday, 21 September**. All shows begin promptly at **18:00** but the children need to be at their classrooms by **17:30** each night.
- **All pupils**, from our Kittens, in the Cottage, to Grade 7 are required to participate in the Revue over **all three evenings**. Specific sequences have been allocated to specific children and with just one absentee it results in all sorts of confusion for the remainder of the class.
- Parents **do not** need to buy tickets for all three evenings – children can be dropped off and will be looked after by their teachers until the end of the show.
- The Veritas Prep children **will not** be permitted into the hall during the show to watch. Pupils have already seen the show at our dress rehearsal. After the class performances all children will return, with their register teachers, to their classrooms until the end of the show. Parents, who are watching the show, can fetch their children from the classrooms after the show.
- The Revue should end by **20:00**.
- A professional video will be made of the show for parents to order @ R150. We do not want audience members walking around during the show taking photos and private videos as this is very distracting for the children and the audience. The video order form was attached to our previous letter.
